Eucharistic Ministers

- Kindly check the Eucharistic Minister schedule for your assigned date/time of Mass as well as the specified position for distributing Communion.
- Ministers should arrive in church 15 minutes before to prayerfully enter into serving in the Mass.
- You should check-in with the Sacristan no later than 5 minutes before and gather in the Sacristy prior to heading to the back of the church to line-up for the procession.
- If you have a pyx to take Communion to for someone after Mass, please give the pyx to the Sacristan and they will put a host in it and set it on a tray at the credence table and placed on the altar at the offertory so that it can be consecrated in the Mass. The pyx will be placed in the tabernacle after Communion where you can retrieve it after Mass to take with you.
- The Presider of the Mass will signal the Music Director and also give the sign for when the procession should start down the aisle.
- Eucharistic Minister's should come forward at the start of the Lamb of God and line up on the side of the altar near the servers. Sanitize your hands after you have personally received but before you take the ciborium to distribute.
- After you distribute Communion return to the Main Altar where the ciborium will be consolidated. Remain momentarily by the altar should the Presider need assistance before heading back to your seat. The Blessed Sacrament will then be taken back to the tabernacle by either one of the priests if present, or otherwise by one of the Eucharistic Minister's or Sacristan.
- Recession out is to the break, making a left and ending at the Ridge Road inner entrance where all briefly pause to venerate the Cross before heading back to the sacristy.

Lectors

- Kindly check the Lector schedule for your assigned date/time of Mass as well as your designated reading.
- Lector's should arrive in church 15 minutes before to prayerfully enter into serving in the Mass.
- You should check-in with the Sacristan no later than 5 minutes before and gather in the Sacristy prior to heading to the back of the church to line-up for the procession.
- The Presider of the Mass will signal the Music Director and also give the sign for when the procession should start down the aisle.
- The Book of Gospels should be carried by Lector #1 (if there is no Deacon) and should be the last one in the procession just prior to the Presiding Priest.
- Lector #2 should close the Lectionary after finishing the second reading and place it under everything already on the ambo shelf.
- Lector #2 should read the Universal Prayer. Proceed up to the ambo near the end of the Creed at the words "*I believe in the Holy Spirit...*" Kindly note that the name for the specific Mass intention is now prayed for as the last intercession – see the list of names identifying the intention for each particular Mass.

Priests Assisting at Communion:

We return to 6 Communion stations beginning weekend of July 24/25th – Presider spot is the front-center aisle and the assisting priest is the center aisle at the break.

Fr. Anthony and Fr. Jose will assist at all the Sunday weekend Masses with distributing Communion – when Msgr. Coleman is presiding, Fr. Anthony will generally assist unless we need extra help or Fr. Anthony is unavailable.
